IIMC Mid-Year Board Meeting Report

The IIMC Board of Directors virtually met on December 2. The Board was originally scheduled to meet in person in Orlando, Florida, in November; however, that meeting was canceled due to Tropical Storm Nicole.

The virtual meeting, held via Zoom, attracted 70 viewers. Below is a summary of the action taken at the December 2, meeting.

• IIMC Constitution Review

- Referred back to the Task Force to consider amendments offered by Board Member Huycke, Region X.
- Process for Discrepancies in CMC/MMC Application Review
 - Approved in-house policy for IIMC staff to follow regarding discrepancies in the CMC/ MMC application process.
 - A copy of the policy is available upon request.

• 2023 Hotel Cancellation Penalty - IIMC Annual Conference

- Approved instituting a one night stay penalty of approximately \$177 upon a guest's cancellation regardless of when or why the cancellation occurs.
- Background. For the 2022 Annual IIMC Conference, IIMC lost approximately \$7,500 from hotel attrition due primarily to conference attendees reserving more than one room only to never utilize the additional rooms. Instituting the penalty is intended to reduce risk to IIMC and leaves the hotel block open longer so that more members have the opportunity to stay in the host hotel.

• Education PLUS Program (EPP)

- Approved program guidelines with a projected launch date of June 2023.
- Background. The new EPP program is not a designation but an addition to the current education programs (CMC/MMC). Members must hold an MMC in good standing to apply to this program. More information about the program will be coming from IIMC. During its inception, this program was often referred to as the Beyond the MMC program.

• IIMC Part-Time Finance Specialist

- IIMC will begin recruitment in January 2023.
- This position requires an individual who has worked in finance. This individual will not be traveling or presenting at Board meetings. Those duties will remain with IIMC CPA Consultant Connie Parker.

Budget and Planning Committee Recommendations for Board Approval

- \$10.00 membership increase. <u>Failed</u>.
- \$25.00 increase in 2023 Conference Delegate Registration. <u>Approved for 2023 only</u>.
- 5 precent increase in IIMC staff salaries, excluding the Executive Director. <u>Approved</u>.
- \$2,400 increase in stipend for parliamentarian at annual conference (brings stipend to \$5,000 annually). <u>Approved</u>.

One of the most frequent questions we hear is, "how much does it cost to attend an IIMC Annual Conference?"

Did you know that IIMC has an awesome tool to help you estimate the cost? It includes a worksheet to determine your registration costs.

From there, the Conference Budget Worksheet will help you estimate hotel, meals, and ground transportation, and incidentals to provide a total conference cost. Take a look at the "Budget Sample" to see a good cost estimate for hotel, meals and ground transportation. Plug in an estimate for your airfare, and you should have a pretty solid estimate to work with.

Strategies for reducing your cost include:

- Share a room with another attendee. Reach out to your State Association and find out who else is going. This can save up to \$500. I've done it for many years and it shows my municipality that I'm invested enough to save the City money if I can.
- Apply for an <u>IIMC Conference Scholarship</u>. Region Directors get to award two members scholarships for conference registrations (\$625). Apply today!
- Hoping to go to both an Institute AND the Conference? Apply for an IIMC Professional Development scholarship and save your City money there. Saving money attending an Institute might be enough to create the leverage you need to go to the Annual Conference.
